SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The funds available for scholarships are directly related to the funds donated to the KC 4-H Horse Club. Therefore, the quantity of scholarships awarded each year fluctuates based on the funds available. Scholarship amounts in the past have ranged from \$250 to \$1,500.

Eligibility requirements:

- Be a member of the KC 4-H Horse Club or enrolled in the 4-H Horse project in Kendall County
- Be in his/her senior year of high school.
- Have applied to and subsequently been accepted to an accredited college, university or technical/vocational school at the time of funding of the scholarship.
- Exhibit leadership and citizenship, as well as involvement in the Horse Club and the Horse Project.
- Provide a completed Scholarship Application with all required attachments **postmarked or by May 1, 2018 to the Texas Agrilife Extension office at 210 E. San Antonio Street, Suite 9, Boerne, or hand-delivered by May 1 to the office at 118 Saunders, Street, Boerne.**

Instructions for submitting an application:

- The application must be fully completed; incomplete applications will not be considered.
- The application deadline is **May 1, 2018**.
 - a. A photocopy of test scores and official school transcript must accompany the application.
- Three non-family member letters of reference must accompany the application.
- Parent signatures are mandatory.
- Applications may be returned to the **Texas Agrilife Extension office by mail at 210 E. San Antonio Street Boerne, or hand-delivered to the office at 118 Saunders, Street, Boerne, Texas.**

Timeline:

- Scholarship applications are at the Texas Agrilife Extension Office or may be downloaded from the Kendall County 4-H Horse Club webpage (<http://kendallcounty4h.org/clubinfo/horseclub.html>)
- Applications are due no later than **May 1, 2018**
- Recipients will be publicly announced in local media and at high school scholarship award ceremonies and other venues as deemed appropriate by KC 4-H Horse Club.

Describe why these projects were important and what impact your involvement provided you to have on other people.

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3. COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

List voluntary community involvement activities in which you have participated outside 4-H and school.
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4. WORK EXPERIENCE

List employment during high school and summer breaks; include start and end dates, employer/supervisor name and phone number, and job duties/hours worked.

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5. EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES
